
TANDEM INSTRUCTION

Tandem Overview

Tandem skydiving allows you to experience freefall on your first skydive! Arrive 30 minutes prior to your class for orientation. Training begins at the scheduled class time. For 20-30 minutes, your instructor will explain the equipment and its safety features, you will physically walk-thru how to exit from the airplane, learn the stable freefall body position and how to fly the parachute back to earth. After ground training, you'll "gear up" and make your first skydive harnessed together with your instructor experiencing the exhilaration of freefall, the freedom of parachute descent, and a tip-toe landing with pin-point accuracy.

Tandem Jump Altitudes & Extras

- Basic tandem skydive is from 8,000-10,000 ft. altitude with a 30-45 second freefall.
- **The price for a basic tandem skydive is \$225.**
- **Upgrade your adventure** with our extra altitude option. For only \$25, skydive from 12,000-14,000 ft. for up to **one full minute of freefall excitement!** (Extra altitude options subject to weather conditions.)

Tandem Scheduling & Availability

- Classes offered Wednesday through Sunday April through October, and Friday through Sunday during winter months.
- The drop zone may open for groups of four or more on Monday and Tuesday by appointment.
- Schedule on our website or call to make your reservation.
- Classes offered at 9am, Noon, 3pm and 6pm.
- Total time investment for tandem skydiving is 3-4 hours.
- Winds must be less than 15 mph; clouds above 8,000 feet. Call before coming to the drop zone to check on weather. If weather prevents tandem skydiving, we will reschedule your skydive at that time.
- Minimum age to jump is 18; maximum weight is 220 lbs.
- Students over the age of 65 must provide written physician approval prior to their appointment.
- Schedule early! Classes fill up quickly!

STATIC LINE INSTRUCTION

Static Line Overview

Static line skydiving is a more self-reliant method for making your first skydive. Arrive 30 minutes prior to your class for orientation.

The static line experience begins with a four-hour ground class training you in the basics of skydiving, the equipment used, and how to properly operate the equipment. Weather permitting, the class is followed by equipment gear-up and inspection. Next, board the aircraft with an instructor, climb to altitude, and exit the airplane wearing your own skydiving equipment. The parachute will deploy automatically via the static line. Through radio communication with a ground instructor, you will steer and glide your parachute safely to our student landing field.

Static Line Jump Altitudes & Extras

- Standard static line skydive is from 3,500 ft. with a 5-6 minute glide to earth.
- **The price for static line training and first jump is \$200.**
- **Upgrade to the "Mile High" skydive** (5,280 feet) for \$25. (Extra altitude options are subject to weather conditions.)
- **Group rates:**
4-6 students: \$190 7-9: \$185 10+: \$175

Static Line Scheduling Availability

- Classes are held most Saturdays, year-round at 9am regardless of weather.
- Groups of four or more scheduled any day by appointment.
- Ground training takes 4-5 hours. Weather permitting, you skydive the same day.
- Total time investment for static line skydiving is 8-10 hours.
- If weather prevents skydiving, you will be rescheduled to a future date and time.
- Minimum age to jump is 18; maximum weight is 250 lbs.
- Students over the age of 65 must provide written physician approval prior to their appointment.
- Schedule early! Classes fill up quickly!

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How long will I be at the drop zone for my first jump?

For a tandem skydive experience, plan on 3 to 4 hours. For static line class and skydive, plan to spend your entire day at the drop zone (8 to 10 hours).

Can I buy a gift certificate?

Gift certificates are available for any of the experiences we offer, or in a denomination of your choice. Order by phone with MC or Visa payment. The skydive is scheduled later by the recipient.

What do I wear?

Wear comfortable clothing and athletic shoes that lace. No shoes or boots with heels or "quick lace" type hooks. Jumpsuits will be available, or you can jump in street clothes.

What will the skydive feel like?

The sensation of freefall feels more like flying than falling. Once the canopy opens, the flight is quiet and the view is breathtaking and exhilarating.

How long does the skydive last?

A tandem skydive will consist of 30 to 60 seconds of freefall, (depending on your exit altitude) followed by a 4-5 minute parachute glide to earth landing at the airport. On a static line skydive, your parachute will be inflated 5 seconds after you leave the airplane, and from there you will enjoy a 5-6 minute glide to the earth safely landing in our student field.

How does the extra altitude benefit me?

If you choose the upgraded tandem skydive, you will DOUBLE your freefall time from 30 seconds to up to one full minute! The additional free fall time is almost like getting another skydive at a fraction of the cost. The static line extra altitude gives more time under parachute. We highly recommend it!

Who will be training me?

United States Parachute Association (USPA) rated Tandem Instructors, Static Line Instructors and Jumpmasters will conduct your training at our USPA-approved drop zone.

What are the differences between tandem and static line skydiving? Ground training is performed in a group setting for both methods of instruction. Tandem allows you to experience freefall with a personal instructor on your first skydive. Training is only 30 minutes for tandem skydiving. The static line skydive allows you to learn more, take on more responsibility, and jump by yourself. Because your rip cord stays attached to the airplane, your canopy is deployed when you exit, and is fully inflated within about 5 seconds. If you're considering getting licensed and want to learn more about the sport, go static line. If you want to experience the sensation and rush but want someone else to take care of the major responsibilities, choose tandem.

SCHEDULING & POLICIES

Reservations: Advance reservations are strongly advised. Our classes fill up quickly. Call (360)568-7703 or schedule online at www.skydivesnohomish.com. We require a non-refundable \$50 deposit for each person on the schedule. Deposits are applied toward the total cost of your skydive.

Cancellation/Reservation Change: Cancellation or changes to your scheduled skydive must be made at least 48 hours prior to your appointment (72 hours for groups up to 6, 1 week for groups of 7+). If you do not give the minimum cancellation notice or do not show up for your class, you will forfeit your deposit. The cancellation policy is strictly enforced for both tandem and static line instruction. Cancellations/Reservation changes must be phoned in.

Weather: **Static line instruction** is held regardless of the weather. If training is complete and poor weather still prohibits jumping, your skydive will be rescheduled. **Tandem skydiving** requires acceptable weather minimums at the drop zone. Please call before you drive to the drop zone for the status of your class. Skydiving will proceed or be rescheduled accordingly.

Note: *Marginal weather is not a valid reason for failing to attend your scheduled skydive. Weather is not a valid reason for canceling your skydive.*

Bad Weather Push-Back for Tandems: Tandem skydives are scheduled for 9 am, noon, 3 pm, and 6 pm. If the weather does not allow you to skydive within your class time, we cannot "push you back" into the next time slot, unless there is space available.

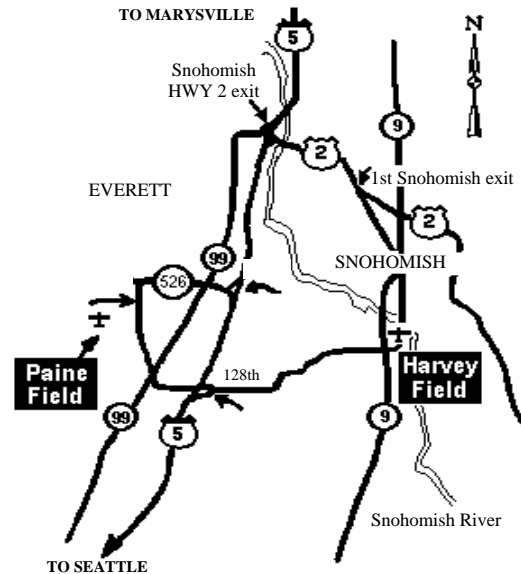

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From I-5: Take exit #186 for 128th St. SE. Head east on 128th St. SE and continue as it becomes 132nd. Pass Seattle Hill Road and keep heading East. The road name will change again to Cathcart Way, but continue until you reach a "T" in the road at Hwy 9. Turn left (north) onto Hwy 9. At the second traffic light, turn right onto Airport Way, and make an immediate left to continue on Airport Way. Follow Airport Way until you see Harvey Field and the Buzz Inn on your left. Turn left into the parking lot and immediately right onto the gravel road heading back to the parking area. Through the gate and on the left is a gravel area for Skydive Snohomish parking.

From I-405: Traveling northbound on I-405 take exit #23 (Hwy 522: Woodinville/Monroe). Go East on Hwy 522 for approx. two miles and take the Hwy 9/Snohomish exit. Go left (north) on Hwy 9 into the Snohomish valley. Turn right on Airport Way, and immediately left to continue on Airport Way. Follow Airport Way until you see Harvey Field and the Buzz Inn on your left. Turn left into the parking lot and immediately right onto the gravel road heading back to the parking area. Through the gate and on the left is a gravel area for Skydive Snohomish parking.

Westbound Hwy 2: Traveling westbound on Hwy 2 take the first Snohomish exit (88th St SE). Turn left at the stop sign onto 92nd Ave SE. Follow the road into Snohomish and turn left at the third light onto Avenue D. Harvey Airfield will be on your right approximately 2 blocks after crossing the river. Turn into the main parking lot at the Buzz Inn restaurant and follow the gravel access road (which runs along the north end) to Skydive Snohomish parking.
